### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

The Treasurer's Report was run from 04/10/2025 to 04/30/2025, the opening balance of account ending #6970 was \$129,909.08. There were disbursements for \$19,128 consisting primarily of the 5th Grade Sacramento trip for \$17,580. With disbursements, the closing balance as of 04/30/2025 is \$110,780.93. The April 2025 bank reconciliation for account ending #6970 has not been reconciled due the bank statement not being available yet.

The opening balance of account ending #1494 was \$123,656.92. There was no activity in this account. The ending balance as of 04/30/2025 is \$123,656.92 and the April 2025 bank reconciliation for account ending #1494 has not been reconciled due the bank statement not being available yet.

### **BUDGET TO ACTUAL**

The Budget to Actuals report was run from 07/01/2024 to 06/30/2025 today. Year to date, there was \$194,204 in income (55% coming from Raise Craze, 31% coming from 5th Grade Committee) and \$113,482 of expenses for this year. 76% were expenses for the Fall Book Fair, Teacher Reimbursements, Classroom Enrichment, Field Trips, Staff Appreciation, Program and Assemblies and 5th Grade Committee
